REGULATIONS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. All sheep **MUST BE** registered or eligible for registration (ie birth notified) with the Texel Sheep Society
- 2. All tags must comply with UK legislation and Society rules on identification.
- 3. All sheep will be sold, subject to the LAA conditions of Sale and the Auctioneers General Conditions of Sale
- All sheep to be eligible for <u>ENTRY MUST</u> be in the top 10% EBV for their breed.
- 5. All sheep will be sold in guineas (105p) with a commission rate of 5%.
- 6. Entry Fees per single sheep: £ 12.00 (plus VAT) = £14.40
- 7. There will be no Show sheep will be entered for sale only.
- 8. Substitutes must be declared to the auctioneers a minimum of 5 days before the sale and are limited to one substitute per vendor, per section. All substitutes will be marked with a red dot on the back.
- 9. Arrivals: All sheep must be delivered to the sale premises on Monday, 8th September 9 am 2pm
- Vendors will be entirely responsible for the correctness of tattoos/tags and also the numbering of sheep for sale. Neck lot numbers will be provided.

- 11. All sheep must be Maedi Visna Accredited and be accompanied by the relevant official certificates.
- 12. Any sheep for sale from which either semen or embryos have been collected must be declared in the sale catalogue.
- 13. Scrapie Genotyping is voluntary.
- 14. Vendors will be responsible for taking their sheep to the sale ring and returning them to the pens.
- 15. A limited amount of straw will be provided within each pen.
- 16. All transactions, either by auction or by private treaty, **MUST BE** passed through the Auctioneers Sale Office.
- 17. Vendors have the right to place a reserve price on any of their sheep. This must be notified to the Auctioneers in writing before the start of the sale.
- 18. Vendors to provide (if they desire) a maximum one A5 page with a Foreword introducing their flock.
- 19. A maximum of 100 sheep is considered to be the ideal number for the sale. It therefore may become necessary to make cut backs to each vendor on a pro rata basis if the sale is oversubscribed.
